An abstract of the paper must be no longer than 300 words, should summarize the contents of the paper and clearly indicate the relevance to the topics of the Symposium. The Symposium language is English (with translations to Czech during Symposium), therefore abstracts must be in English.

Abstracts and papers will be peer-reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The authors will be notified by e-mail about their abstract acceptance or rejection. The formatting instructions for the paper will be available soon.

All accepted full papers can be published in IOP Conference Series: Materials Science and Engineering and indexed in Scopus, Conference Proceedings Citations Index (ISI Web of Science), Compendex, Inspec and other databases. The papers will be published as Open Access (online as a single volume). It is optional possibility and in that case authors must pay additional 50 €.
